In the name of God Amen this 30th day of April one thousand Seven hundred & Twenty I Wm Mitchell being sick and weak in body but of sound & perfect memory praise be given to almighty God for the same & willing to mind the uncertainty of this present Life on Earth and being desirous to settle things in order to make this my Last Will & Testament Viz First and principally I commend my Soul into the hands of almighty God hoping thro' the precious Death of my only Saviour & Redeemer Jesus Christ to find pardon & Redemption of all my sins and be saved by Vertue of his precious Death & passion & my body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such Christian Decent manner as to my Executors or Executor hereafter named shall think meet, and as touching such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy hath sent me my will & meaning is that the same be employed as hereafter mentioned Revoking frustrating & making void all wills by me formerly made & declaring this to be my Last Will & Testament & none other. In witness whereof I give & bequeath unto my Son Wm Mitchell Two cows & calves to be delivered to him at his arrival at the age of Twenty one years, and he like so Wm Mitchell shall live & abide with my Loving wife Jane Mitchell until he comes to that age of 21 years also I give & bequeath unto the sd Wm Mitchell one Shute of Cloth. Further I do order that the sd Will Mitchell shall have four year schooling if opportunity permits convenient as soon as he is capable of taking Learning also I do bequeath to him a gun to be delivered at y^e time of age of 21 years with a proviso that he is to be

the age of 21 years & not otherwise with her, Item I Give & bequeave
unto my Son John Mitchell Two Sows and Pigg and an 2 ew Lambs
and a Shute of Goats. at his arrivall at the age of Twenty one years
if he stays with my Loving wife Jane Mitchell during of 21 years and
I do order my Loving wife upon that proviso to give him 2 years Schooling
also I Give & bequeave unto him a gun at his arrivall at 21 years of
age and not otherwise. Item I Give and bequeave unto my Loving wife
Jane Mitchell and the Child that she is bigg with all & singular of my
Estate Moveable & immoveable Lints & Dead to be equally divided
between them, two to them & their heirs for ever, as also the Increase of
the said Estate, the Child as well as my Loving wife Jane Mitchell to be
Equally divided between them, and each of them to have an Equall share
of all the Estate none Excepted. If in case the Child should dye in its
Infancy that then the said Estate to return or remain wholly unto my
Loving wife Jane Mitchell & her heirs for ever Turn over.
Lastly I do constitute and appoint my dear & loving wife Doratrix &
Mr. Godfrey Pike Esq. of this my Last Will & Testament In Witness
of which I do hereunto set my hand and seal this 30th Day of April 1720
