 in the County of Essex being sick and weak but of sound and perfect memory thanks be to the all mighty
 God there fore do make and ordains this my last will and testament in manner & form following first
 principally I commend my soul into the hands of almighty God which gave it me & wholly trusting in
 the resurrection of eternal life and my body to the earth to be buried in decent & Christian like manner
 at the discretion of my friends hereafter named & as for what personal estate it hath pleased almighty
 God to bestow upon me I give devise and dispose thereof in manner & form following first I give to my son
 Charles Waller the one half of my Land in Stafford County on a quiet peace to him & his Lawfull heirs begotten
 of his body for ever & from I give the other half of the said Land to my son William Waller to him & his
 Lawfull heirs begotten of his body for ever to be equally divided in quantity in quality & between them
 and if either of them dies without a male heir his parts & share of Land to fall to my son William
 Waller & his Lawfull heirs begotten of his body for ever in case my son William Waller will pay
 to either brother living half the worth of my Land in Essex County from I give to my son William
 Waller all my Land in Essex County to him & his Lawfull heirs begotten of his body for ever & for
 want of such to fall to my son Charles paying his other Edward half the worth of it from I give
 to my two daughters Hannah Waller & Sarah Waller twenty pound current money a piece to be paid
 out of my estate Lastly my will & desire is that all the remainder of my estate may be equally divided
 between my loving wife Susanna Waller and all my Children last I make constitute and ordains
 my loving wife Susanna Waller my whole sole executrix of this my last will & testament making
 and all others by me made & made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year
 first above written

Know all men by these presents that we Susanna Waller James Rennolds & John Galewood
 are held & firmly bound unto William Dainge & John Lawrence Solicitors for the Justices of the County of Essex
 in the sum of five hundred pounds Sterling to the which payment we are
 bound to be made we bind ourselves our heirs & assigns jointly & severally to the said Justices their heirs
 and assigns firmly by these presents witness our hands & seals this 11th day of November Anno 1725
The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound Susanna Waller doinde of all
 the goods chattels and debts of Charles Waller deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory
 of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands or
 possession of the said Susanna or into the hands & possession of any other person or persons for her
