Constitut reciting all former wills whatsoever. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth
Barnard Esqre One Shilling Sterl money to be paid her after my death. Item I give unto my
Daughter Anna Blakeson One Shilling Sterl to be paid her selfe for her full part of all my Real
& personal Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Dorothy Blakeson as a Dower of
last Iron pot I now use Item give unto my Daughter Frances Blakeson my last Ring, Rattle
as a Dower Likewise Item I give unto my colored wife all my Land & plantacion houses and
Orchard entred I never live during her natural life and after her deces to my Eldest Child & his heirs
for ever but if he die without issue here my will is that it come to my Daughter Elizabeth &
my Daughter Frances Blakeson and their heirs for ever. Also my will is that all my personal
Estate that is not before given to be equally divided between my colored wife & my daughter also
Blakeson and daughter Judith Blakeson and my Daughter Dorothy Blakeson and my
Daughter Mylesford Blakeson and my daughter Frances Blakeson & my daughter Judith Blakeson
and do appoint my colored wife and my daughter the Blakeson to be witnesses of this my last
will & Testament As witness my hand & seal this 28th day of August 1722.
