Testament touching all former wills whatsoever. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Deborah
Samuel's Tithing one Shilling Sterl. money to be paid her after my death. Item I give unto my
Daughter Anna Blareston one Shilling Sterl. to be paid hereafter for her full part of all my Estate
Real & personal. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Deborah Blareston as a Legacy y.
last I have put I now make Item give unto my Daughter Deborah Blareston my last & best
as a Legacy Deborah. Item I give unto my beloved wife all my Land & plantation thereof and
thereof reserved. I were live during her natural life and after her death to my son August & his heirs
for ever but if he die without heirs then my will is that it come to my Daughter Deborah
my Daughter Frances Blareston and their heirs for ever. Also my will is that all my personal
Estate that is not before given to be equally divided between my beloved wife & my Daughter all
Blareston and daughter Judith Blareston and my Daughter Deborah Blareston and my
Daughter Elizabeth Blareston and my Daughter Frances Blareston & my son August Blareston
and do appoint my beloved wife and my daughter all Blareston to be his Exors. of his my last

pounds Sterl. to the 20. paym. well & truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs &
personally firmly by these presents. In Witness whereof we have signed our names & seal this 10. day of February 1722.
