York in the parish of Saint Mary in the colony of Virginia being weak of body but
in perfect memory and memory thanks to almighty God for it do make this my
Last Will & Testament: and first I give my Soul to God that gave it & my body to
the Earth to be buried according to y^e direction of my Executors hereafter named
in sure and certain hope of a joyfull resurrection to life everlasting through the
merits & mediation of my Lord & Saviour, Jesus Christ according to y^e true faith
of a Christian. Secondly I give & bequeath my worldly goods as followeth
viz. I give to Robert Anyan all that parcel of Land & plantation whereon he
now lieth situate lying & being in the County & parish aforesaid & between the
deep branch and the line of Division between me & Taliaferro and from the main
run off Downland up the said branch and the line to Mr. Ju^r. Salletts jnd Quarters
be it more or less to him & to his heirs & assigns for ever. Thirdly I give all my
right title & interest of me & to all that Land whereon Ju^r. Ellys now lieth to
Robert Taliaferro son of Francis Taliaferro w^{ch} said Land and that I now live on
being taken up in partnership between the said Francis Taliaferro & I & the division
now acknowledged, to him & to his heirs & assigns for ever. Fourthly & lastly
I give after my debts & funeral charges are paid to my beloved wife Susanna
all the rest of my Land & Negro's and goods & chattels to her & to her
heirs & assigns for ever and likewise I do ordain constitute & appoint
my said wife my true and Lawfull Executor to this my Will & to
execute all other Wills formerly made & do with my own hand sign
and seal this as my Last Will & Testament in the presence of those witnesses
this 29. day of March 1722.
