understanding thanks be given to Almighty God for the same do  
make and ordaine this my last will & testament in Manner  
form following Imprio I give & bequeath my soul into the hands  
of Almighty God my creator & redeemer hoping through the merits

of my blessed saviour Jesus Christ to receive full pardon and free remis-  
sion of all my sins and my body to the earth from whence it was taken  
to be buried in such decent and Christian manner as to my executors  
hereafter named shall seem meet and convenient and as to what -  
worldly estate the Lord in his mercy hath lent me I give & bequeath  
as follows vizt I give & give unto my daughter Winnifred my land  
and plantation whereon I now live and to the heirs on her body -  
lawfully begotten for ever and for want of such issue to my daughter  
Anne & the heirs on her body lawfully begotten for ever and for want -  
of such issue to my daughter Susannah and the heirs on her body -  
lawfully begotten for ever and for want of such issue unto my daughter  
Marcy & to her heirs & assigns for ever - Item I give unto my  
daughter Winnifred my negro girl called Winne & her increase -  
for ever - Item I give unto my daughter Anne my negro boy called  
Billo and to heirs for ever - Item I give unto my daughter Susan-  
nah twenty pounds currant money of Virginia to be paid out of my  
estate - Item I give unto my daughter Marcy twenty pounds  
currant money of Virginia to be also paid out of my estate wch p'd  
negroes and money's are to be paid and delivered up to them when  
they arrive to the age of one & twenty years or dayes of marriage  
which shall first happen - Item I give unto my beloved wife Rebecka  
my negro man called Jack & her horse & saddle & my best setting bed & furniture  
& other & her heirs for ever - Item my will & desire is that my  
beloved wife Rebecka have hold use occupy possess and Enjoy all my estate  
real & personal during the term of her naturall life & giving  
good and sufficient security to my executors hereafter named -  
Item my will & desire is that my children be kept and maintained -  
whereon I now live out of the produce of my estate until they arrive  
to their severall ages of one & twenty years or many which shall  
first happen - Item my will & desire is that after my just debts  
and legacys are fully satisfied and paid that all the residue & remainder  
of my estate be equally divided in value and kind amongst my sd  
four children & their heirs for ever and that my people be kept and  
lookt on my plantation until my sd children arrive unto their  
sd ages or day of marriage as aforesd - And lastly I do hereby  
nominate constitute and appoint my beloved kinsmen John &  
James Webb my whole & sole executors of this my last will & testament
