Money to me in James Griffins hands due & to be  
during her life & after her decease to be equally divided  
between my four sisters Sarah Morell, Elizabeth Gore, -  
Mary Fullerton, Penelope Fullerton & Hannah Fullerton.  
And I doe appoint my Mother Sarah Webb to be my lawfull  
Executor & I do acknowledge this to be my last will &  
Testament as it touches my hand and seal this seventeenth  
day of June one thousand seaven hundred & twenty seaven.
