wills heretofore by me made doth in the first place Comitt my Soul to God that gave it in shure and certain
hope of the Resurrection to salvation in the world to come in & therein the blessed merits of my Saviour
Jesus Christ and my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Ex^{ors} hereafter named and as for all my
goods and estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me with all after my just debts are paid I bestow and bequeath
it is my will and desire that the Land which I possess to me in Widdesb^o County divided between my well beloved
Goare and my daughter Seljann Goare to their heirs for ever I give I lend to my Well beloved Eliz^z Goare her natural
Heir in all my Land whersoever I now dwell provided she doth not marry againe but if so be she doth marry she shall have the
third part of my two daughters Seljann Goare & Beatty Goare after the division of their mother at my death I now dwell
on to be equally divided between them or at the time either of them shall come of age or marry to them or to the
heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten or to the Survivour of them I will it is my will and desire that the first
born Child that I shall have be made over by Assignment to my daughter Seljann Goare within one month
after it is born to her heirs for ever I give I lend to my daughter Seljann Goare & her heirs my Young boy
named with baule faw^{er} Cante^{er} & her surcoise for ever I give I lend to my daughter Seljann Goare four
hundred one hundred rumples with all and p^{er}sonal effects the other the Breton Good Yearling and old dead lamb
Yearling raised while I live I give I lend to her surcoise for ever but if ever I should be turned into
money for her use I give I lend to my daughter Seljann Goare & her heirs four ewes and lambs with their
future surcoise but if ever I should be turned into I give I lend to my daughter Seljann Goare & her heirs
Lamb and piggs to the Value of twenty Shillings at the day of Marriage or at one Twenty I give I lend to my
Daughter Seljann Goare & her heirs one young pair two powder dishes shall a dozⁿ of plates
I give I lend all the rest of my personal estate to be equally divided between my well beloved wife and my daughter
Beatty Goare to their heirs for ever I will it is my will and desire that the present sum of Twenty pound and
for the use of my family and the heirs of my daughter I give I lend to my well beloved wife
Eliz^z Goare my well beloved friend & her heirs for ever of this my last will and Testament to see it fully
