heires of their bodies lawfully begotten or to the survivor of them Item it is my will and desire that the first  
born child that Michaela Gallaher be made over by assignment to my daughter Lely Ann Peare within one month  
after its birth to her heirs for ever Item I give to my daughter Lely Ann Peare other heirs my young boy  
named Willm Bawle said Name other heires for ever Item I give to my daughter Lely Ann Peare four  
horses and cales rumpes with a salt one pied heifer the other three crowns leaved yearling and old dead lambes  
sparkling white bark them other heires to her other heires for ever but if sooner than ten years turned into  
money for her use Item I give to my daughter Lely Ann Peare other heirs four webs and lambs with their  
future increase but if our childrens to be turned into slain I give to my daughter Lely Ann Peare other heires two  
webs and piggys to the value of thirty shillings at the day of their marriage or at one threentie pence given to my  
Daughter Lely Ann Peare for her heires and issue poll and buying all her powder drisses & halfe a dozen of plates  
Item I give all the rest of my goods the whole equally divided betwix my well beloved wife and my daughter  
Eliz Peare to their heirs for ever Item it is my will and desire that the present sum of £1000 be laid out  
for the use of my family and to furnish into the necessary charge for my funeral expences against my well beloved wife  
Eliz Peare my well beloved friends to whom fully paid off this my last will and Testament to see it fully
