

all the Land belonging to it to him & his heirs & his cast and residue of my Estate after my debts & funeral
expenses discharged to be equally divided amoungst my wife and all my Children & I give unto the said
John during his life to my wife during her widowhood & to my next sons John Hawes & Joseph
Hawes & my three children born of my first wife I do make & seal this 1st day of January
& Testament recouning all other wills heretofore by me made and in case my wife shall die before me
stand to this my will and Testament notwithstanding what is given above I cut off all my Children with
a English Inlet from any part or parcel of any of my Estate witness my hand & seal this 1st day of January
1722


