County of Essex being of well and perfect mind & memory but very sick and low in body calling to
mind the mortality and uncertainty of life do make and ordain this my last will and Testament
Revoking and disanulling and making void all other wills & Testaments heretofore made by
me and this to be taken for my last will and Testament for evermore and in manner or form
as followeth, first I bequeath my soul into y^e hand of y^e Almighty God who gave it me in sure &
certain hopes of a joyfull resurrection at y^e last day through & by the merits of & intercessions
of my ever blessed saviour, Iesus Christ and my body to be buried in such manner and form
and as the time and place will afford where I shall render my life and as for my worldly goods
as hath pleased the Almighty God to bestow on me I thus bequeath them, Viz^t Item I will that
all my debts that I do owe to any person be first honestly paid Item I give to my son Thomas Hawkins
seven hundred acres of Land that he is now possessed with and laid off by John Vawter to him &
his heirs for ever, Item I give to the said Thomas Hawkins one negro fellow named Sam to be
Delivered to him immediately after my Death in the lieu of all his estate both real &
Personal Item I give to my Son William, all the rest of my land I now live on excepting
two hundred acres that is to be lent to his mother in law at this place Item I give unto
the said William Hawkins three fives negros here mentioned Jack Han Hector, Dick Han
and Joans after my wifes widowhood to her & her heirs for ever, Item I give unto my
Daughters Mary Hawkins & Elizabeth Renolds that seat of Land called Jacks hills to
be equally divided betwixt them to them & their heirs for ever, Mary taking the lower
part Item I give to Elizabeth Renolds five negros already given to her & her heirs for
ever Item I give unto my daughter Mary Hawkins five negros by name Moll George
Kate Plimoth & Jos to her & her heirs for ever and after my wifes widowhood I give
Tom to her & her heirs for ever, Item I give to my son William Hawkins all the land I
bought of Larkin Tice to him & his heirs for ever, Item I give all the rest of my personal
Estate to be equally divided betwixt my two Children William & Mary Hawkins & my
Loving wife for ever, Item I will that David Frazer work in the Shop and that it be equally
divided betwixt my wife & Children and that after my son William is of age for to have y^e
Smiths tools. Item I nominate constitute and appoint my loving wife Grace Hawkins
to be whole and sole Ex^{or}. of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & Seal this 16. day of February 1725/6.
