very sick & weak but of perfect & true memory do make this my last will & Testament revoking
all other wills whatsoever in my name first I bequeath my Soul to Jesus Christ that gave it
in sure & certain hope of the resurrection of both body and Soul at the last day and my body to
be buried according to the direction of my Friends and for what Estate it hath pleased God to bestow
upon me I bequeath as followeth. Item I give to my loving wife Jane Shepard Surry a
negro woman and two Children Janny and Phillis & their issue during her natural life if
she keeps single and at her death to be equally divided between Joseph Rogers & James
Rogers but if she marries then the said negroes shall fall to the said Joseph Rogers and
James Rogers at the day of her marriage. Item I give to my loving wife four feather
beds and furniture during her natural life but if she marries then at the day of her
marriage two of this feather beds to fall to Joseph Rogers & James Rogers equally but if
she keeps single she shall keep the beds during her life & after all four to be equally
divided between Joseph Rogers & James Rogers. Item I give to my loving wife twelve head of
Cattle during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided between Joseph Rogers
& James Rogers. Item I give to James Rogers my young horse. Item I give to Elizabeth
My wife of three years old & I make my loving wife Jane Shepard full and sole
Executrix of this my last will and Testament Witness my hand and seal this 8. day of
December 1793.
