to die sometime this my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say first & equally my
soul into the hands of my creator not doubting but through the merits of my blessed Saviour to receive
paradise & forgiveness of all my sins & joyful refection with the just & elect at the day of Judgment & for
what worldly good it shall please almighty God to bestow on me in this life after my just debts paid & queas.
followeth In primitib: to my will & desire that my loving wife Ez: Brown have the use of my estate
estate during her life both real & personal from & give unto my loving son John Brown after the
decease of my said wife Ez: my plantation where now lies all the land belonging thereto which I bought
of William Smith by deeds will appear to him & his heirs for ever Item I give & bequeath unto my
said son John Brown my daughter Ez: Brown all the rest & remainder of my estate be it of
any kind or nature whatsoever after the decease of my said wife to be equally divided between them
their heirs for ever Item it is my will & desire that if my said wife Ez: Brown shall marry again
after my decease that then they shall immediately give security for the whole estate that it shall not be
destroyed nor impeached away but that it shall remain for the use of said children John Brown &
Ez: Brown & their heirs for ever & further it is my desired that my truly friend Samuel Taylor
will see this my will performed & lastly I do appoint & ordain my loving wife Ez: Brown to be
whole & full executor of this my last will & Testament as witness my hand & Seal this 17th day of
January 1725/6.
