(here over) I give to my daughter Ann Gunstall two hundred Pounds
& fifty Sterling. I give to my two daughters Betty & Catherine Hill -
four hundred Pounds Sterling to each of them and it is my desire
that my two daughters Betty & Catherine Hill to be maintained
by their Brother Leonard Hill or his heirs till they come to the age
of eighteen years or married & afterward to be maintained out
of their portions by their Brother Leonard Hill. If either of my
two daughters Betty or Catherine Hill should die before they come
to the age of eighteen years & not married then the decess property
portion to be equally divided between their Brother Leonard Hill -
the surviving sister Betty & Catherine Hill I give and bequeath
to my son Leonard Hill all my lands Plantacions & grise Woods
plate cash goods & merchandizing debts growing or coming in
the dead to lie & his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my
Godson John Covington son of Leonard to buy him a feather bed -
I do appoint my son Leonard Hill to be my sole Executor. This
is my last will & Testament & revoking all others & it is -
my desire that my Estate may not be appraised & divided
till the next General Court held at this 12th day of May 1728.

my desire that my Estate may not be appraised & no sale
made and sealed this 12th day of May 1728.
