all my Children excepting my son Moses it my desire that my son James
James & John Carnall shall be at age for their selves at the age of sixteen
Yearsold I give all the rest of my Estate to my son Moses Carnall to bring
my Children and and give them sufficient schooling & make provision my
son Moses Carnall my Executor of this my last will & Testament in
witness whereunto I set my hand & seal
