Diet for Travellers and stableage fodder & provender or pasturage & provender as y^e person
shall require for their horses for & during the term of one year from the day of the date
hereof and shall not suffer or permit any unlawful gaming in his house nor on the Sabbath
day suffer any to tipple or drink more than is necessary then this Obligation to be null & void
and of none effect otherwise to be & remain in full force power & virtue

County of Essex being in good health of body & in full mind & memory thanks be given to
God, therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my Body & considering that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament that is to say
primarily & first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it
& my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in Christian like & decent manner at
the direction of my Executor or Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching mine earthly
State wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & devise & bequeath
of the same in the following manner & form I give & bequeath to my beloved wife a Mary
when I shall make & ordain my Executor of this my Last Will & Testament all my State with
Real & personal living of her Natural life. Item I give to Thomas Willis Esq^r attorney
of Law do by & last one shilling piggie go forth to the furniture one pot & one pan to him &
the heirs of the body but if he should die without heirs of the own body my will is that Thomas
Jameson enjoy the same for ever. Item I give all the rest of my State after my wife's death
with real & personal to Thomas Jameson & his heirs for ever but if he should die without issue
I give it to James Jameson to him & his heirs for ever, my will is that James Jameson should have
with my wife & do hereby wholly disallow revoke & disannul all those former Testaments Wills
Legacies and Bequests and Executors or Executrices by him ever
