 and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever.

 negro named Jenevany to that be it boy or girl to it or its
 heirs lawfully begotten of its body for ever. I Item I give
 and bequeath to my beloved wife Pasant Galewood one
 white riding horse and side saddle and bridle and whip
 and the best bed & furniture. I Item I give and bequeath
 to my beloved daughter Ann Galewood four negroes named
 Anna, & Eve, Grace, and Ben, they and their increase to her
 and her heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever.
 I Item I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Clara
 Galewood four negroes named Ned, Hammer, Lucy, & N. they
 and their increase to her and her heirs lawfully begotten
 of her body for ever. I Item I give and bequeath to my
 beloved son Richard Galewood five negroes named Judy,
 Tom, Geo, Minus, & Mover, they and their increase to him
 and his heirs lawfully begotten of his body for ever, and
 a feather bed and a rug a blanket, & sheat and five head of
 cattle two cows one mare of five year old two two year olds
 one small one & one large one and five head of hogs -
 two sows and three barrow and one unbroke mare. I Item
 I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Galewood a feather
 bed, and a rug a blanket & sheat and five head of cattle
 two cows one mare of five year old, two two year olds
 and five head of hogs two sows and three barrow.
 I Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Clara Galewood
 a feather bed and a rug a blanket, & sheat and five head
 of cattle two cows one mare of seven year old two two year
 olds and five head of hogs two sows and three barrow.
 I Item I give and bequeath to my four youngest children Eliz^d
 Galewood, Pasant Galewood & Sarah Galewood and the child
 y^e unborn all the rest of my beds and bedding that is not

before given and likewise my will and desire is that all my
 Lattell and hoggs that is not before given to be equally divided
 between my wife and her four Children - I lend to my beloved
 wife the land that I now live upon that goes to the roads that
 lead to the old mill bridge during her natural life and
 then to return to the next heir after the crop is finished y^t
 is now growing upon it - I give unto my beloved
 wife five pound current money and the rest of my money
 to be equally divided amongst all my Children - I give
 one old silver tankard and a silver spoon and a pair
 of silver buckles to my beloved wife Pasant Gatewood - I give
 my will and desire is that the rest of my Estate that I have
 not yet given away shall be equally divided amongst my
 wife and seven Children - I give it is my will and desire
 that David Scott as soon as my will is proved and my estate
 is appraised and that to be done within two months after
 my death if Courts permit then David Scott to divide
 my estate according to the words of the will - I give
 I give to my beloved wife a pair of new slippers and a pair
 of shoes - I give I do hereby appoint and constitute my
 brother Thomas Gatewood Executor of my son Richard
 Gatewood's part - I give I do hereby appoint and constitute
 my Mother Aimey Baker and my brother James Gatewood
 Executors of my two daughters Ann Gatewood and Clara
 Gatewood of their parts. I give I do hereby appoint and
 constitute my beloved wife Pasant Gatewood and David
 Scott to be Executors of her part and her four Children
 part Elizabeth Gatewood and Pasant Gatewood and Sarah
 Gatewood and one that is unborn of this my last will and
 Testament revoking and disannulling all other wills
 and Testaments before made by me July y^e 17th 1730 re-
