remain in full power & Virtue I Item I bequeath my soul to God

of my Exec^{rs}. James Wall I Item I give to James Wall three hundred
Pounds of tobacco this tobacco given for the schooling of my well
beloved son William Roberts two years schooling and to be bound
an apprentice to the said James Wall & his wife Mary Wall till
he come to the age twenty one years I Item I give to my son
William Roberts all my land to him & his heirs for ever I Item
I give my son William Roberts all my Personal Estate after my
Debts paid & to have it in his Possession when he comes to the

Age of twenty one years
