and County of Essex do make and ordain this my last will & Testament in manner and form
as followeth I send to my Beloved wife Elizabeth Dunn all my Estate during her life but
her death to be disposed of as I shall hereafter Direct. I give my land & Plantations
to be Equally Divided amongst my three sons Benjamin Dunn Dickson Dunn and
Anthony Crook Dunn to them and their heirs forever. Item I give to my ^{son} Philip Dunn twenty
shillings Sterling to him and his heirs forever. Item I give to my son Benjamin Dunn my
biggest Iron pot one feather bed & one bow to him and his heirs forever. Item
I give to my son Benjamin Dunn one bow and one Iron pot to him & his heirs forever.
Item I give to my son Anthony Crook Dunn one bow and one Iron pot & one feather bed & one
to him & his heirs forever. Item I give to my Daughter Judith Crook one feather bed she has now
in her possession. The Rest of my Estate after the payment of my Just Debts I give to be Equally
Divided amongst all my living children to them and their heirs forever. Lastly I constitute
appoint Mary Dunn and Dickson my Executors to this my last will given under my hand & Seal
this 17th of April 1778.

 in her possession. The Rest of my Estate after the payment of my Just Debts I give to be Equally
 Divided amongst all my living Children to him and their heirs forever. Lastly I constitute &
 appoint my son Benjamin and Benjamin Dunn my Executors to this my last will & in my hand & seal
 this 17th of April 1772.
