goods which it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I Will bequeath
them. Item I lend unto my nephew John Brawtins the tract of land I hold upon
the river containing two Hundred acres he paying my sister Sabina Brawtins
Children the sum of Two Hundred pounds specie with legal interest thereupon till
paid to them & their heirs forever. If my nephew John Brawtins dies without law-
ful heir of his own body my will is that the above mentioned land should descend
to the next Heir. Item I give to my sister Mosley Brawtins all my stock of all
kinds to her & her heirs forever. Item I give to my sister Margaret Brawtins four
negroes Tom Rose Mary Bob with their increase to her & her heirs forever. Item I give
to my cousin Mary Sandrums One negro Mingo to her & her heirs forever & the
Rest of my estate not mentioned I give to be equally divided among my

ful heir of his own body my will is that the above mentioned Land should descend
to the next Heir. Item I give to my sister Mosley Rowell all my stock of all
kinds to her & her heirs forever. Item I give to my Sister Margaret Hawkins four
negroes Tom Rose Cary Bob with their increase to her & her heirs forever. Item I give
to my cousin Mary Sandrums One negro Mingo to her & her heirs forever & the
Rest of my estate not mentioned I give to be equally divided among my
Sister Boutwells children to them & their heirs forever. Item if either the rest
of my legacies dies without lawful heir of their own body my will & desire
is that their part so dying shall be equally divided among the rest then
living. Attest I appoint my Brother Thomas Hawkins & William Rowell
Executors to this my last will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this ninth Day of April One thousand Seven hundred
& Eighty One
