money to be equally divided between them, being the sum arising from the sale
of the land given by Colonel Thomas Rouse & also of two negroes last for the
use of her & the Children, that were sold by me. It is my will & desire that
all my Just debts should be paid by my executors and the remainder of my
estate both real and personal be Equally divided between my wife Sarah
Campbell and my Children by her, to them and their heirs forever. It is
my will & desire that if my wife should be delivered of another Child (of which
she is supposed to be pregnant) that the said Child shall be entitled to an equal
share of my estate with the rest. I do hereby constitute & appoint my beloved
wife Sarah Campbell my Executrix, and my worthy Friends Robert Patton
William Rouse and John Marden Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

to be recorded. Rane acknowledged according to law, whereupon a Certificate
was granted to the said William Rane in order to his obtaining probate
of the said Testament in due form
