

In the name of God Amen. I Hugh Waters of the County of Essex and parish of South Hamham. do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament, in the manner and form as followeth To wit.

Item, I Give to my beloved Wife all my Estate as long as she lives a widow, and if in case she chooseth to marry that then I Give it to my Son John and his heirs forever and if my Son John hereafter mentioned, shall ever Covenant to sell any part of my Estate or all of it, that it shall be sold in behalf of my Son John Waters.

Item I Give to my beloved Wife Ten Shillings for a week that she may dwell, and then to attend to what I have ordained or take as the Church directeth in.

Item Lastly I Appoint my neighbours and friends Peter Tuckley & Robert Mann wholly to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament. I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28. day of Decemb^r 1774.
