else during her life or widowhood except what is now excepted if
my girls should marry or go away they each of them shall have
a feather bed and covering and each of them a cow and calf and
these goods to be valued by honest men and when these mother
dies and the rest sold the money shall be all put together
and equally divided among 3 children James John and Maria

I further promise after my widow's decease that my land horses
stock and every thing be the Land to be sold for eight months
that that is one half of the money to be paid at nine months
and the other at eight months the horses cattle and goods

I further ordain after my decease that my land horses
stock and every thing to the Land to be sold for eight months
that that is one half of the money to be paid at nine months
and the other eight months the horses cattle and everything
at 6 months exact given to me and Secut to my Executors hereafter
named.

I give to my Son James my land and every thing

I further ordain that if any will before they are the first of
their estate it shall be equally be divided between the two
daughters.

I am my wife and my son James of this my last
will and testament to be my Executors signed and
sealed in the presence of me the day of April 1796
