& Parish of St. Anne do make this my last Will & Testament for settling
my Temporal concerns recommending my soul when called, to the mercy
of my Creator and Redeemer and my Body to the Earth to be buried
in a decent manner

Item I give to my daughter Betty Smith one negroe named Peter
now in her possession to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my Son and Daughter Molly Moll Daughter of
Betty Smith my Negro woman Jude and her increase to her
and her heirs forever.

I Give to my son Samuel Hawes my Negro Man named An-
thony now in his possession to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my son Thomas Hawes my negro Boy named Peter
now in his possession to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my son James Hawes my negro Woman named Mogg
and my Negro Boy Medd now in his possession to him and his heirs
for ever. I also give to my said son James my Distill with the
Cap worn and every thing belonging thereto.

Item I send to my two Grandsons John Barbee & James Barbee
my two negro Girls Ester & Sarah with their Increase to them
and their heirs forever equally to be divided but if they should
die without a Child or Children lawfully begotten then it is my
desire that the said Negroes and their increase be equally divided
among such of my Children as shall be living.

Item I give to my Grandson Isaac Hawes son of John Hawes
one Negro Boy call'd Cheser one Feather Bed & furniture a cow &
half a sow & Pigg two ewes one Colt one third of the brood of the
growth of the year that I depart this life to be delivered to him
Whenever he comes of Age or Marrys and also that the said Isaac

Isaac Hawes is to be Boarded. Maintained by John
Horn I give & devise to my son Isaac Hawes and
Residue of my Estate of what Nature or Kind I ever
I appoint my friends Capt. Lee & Henry Gannett. and my son
Hawes my Executors to this my last Will & Testament Sealed
and Published by me this 19th Day of November 1786
