Item my Two Negroes Carpenters Ben and Sam to be hired and the money they hire for to be Equally divided between my Three Children William Jordan Thomas Jordan and Susannah ^{Jordan} to them and their heirs for ever.

Item my Land in the County of Charlotte Containing one hundred and fourteen acres I desire may sold and the money it sells for to be Equally divided between my Three Children William Jordan Thomas Jordan and Susannah Jordan to them and their heirs for ever.

Item my Land in the County of Charlotte Containing one hundred
and fourteen acres I desire may sold and the money it sells for

sixty two acres I desire may be sold and the money it sells for to
be Equally divided between my Three Children William Jordan

Item I send to my Loving Wife Mary Jordan all the Remain-
der part of my Estate that I have not devised during her Widow-
hood and immediately after her decease the said Estate to be
Equally Divided between my Three Children William Jordan

(6) Thomas Jordan and Susannah Jordan and their heirs forever
do hereby constitute and appoint and ordain my well beloved Friends
Thomas Evans Eben Davis and John Mann Together with my Loving
Wife Mary Jordan to be my whole Executors and Executrix hereby
Ratifying and confirming Every matter and thing They shall think
proper towards the Education of my Children Fourteenth day
of March 1726.
