head of Hogs, one bed and Furniture, one Pot and Hooks, Ten Dishes
Five Plates, Four Basins, Two Fat Hogs, to her and her heirs forever
I also give to my Daughter Zilpah Canaday, Three cows,
Three Plates, one Dish, to her and her heirs forever, Then I also give
to my Daughter Margaret Canaday, the Bed and Furniture she has
now in Possession, and two Pots and Hooks. Then I also give to my
Daughters Sarah and Zilpah one Horse, and one Mare, and the
Bed and Furniture, for the use of the Plantation to them during

Then a Personal Letter. Item. I give to my Daughters Sarah and
Zephah All the born, Bacon, and all other Articles, belonging to
the Plantation for their Uses, and their heirs forever, Lastly I
Ordain, and Make this my last Will and Testament, in Testimo-
ny Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
fourteenth day of January, in the Year of our Lord, one
thousand seven hundred and seventy four.
