 can be most conveniently spared Remainder of my house & Kitchen
 Furniture & Stock to be divided in the following Manner One Third to
 my worthy Loving Wife Anna Garnett & the other two Thirds to my
 Daughter Molly Garnett Except my Carriage Horses & Carriages
 which I give my Wife exclusive of her Dower in my Personal Estate
 & in my power from Law or Equity I give all the Lands whereof I am
 Possesed to my Daughter Molly Garnett & her heirs forever Together with

my Meane house & Kitchen Furniture & such part of my stock as
can be most conveniently spared Remainder of my house & Kitchen
Furniture & stock to be divided in the following Manner One Third to
my worthy Loving Wife Anna Garnett & the other two Thirds to my
Daughter Molly Garnett Except my Carriage Horses & Carriages
which I give my Wife exclusive of her Dower in my Personal Estate
If in my power from Law or Equity I give all the Lands whereof I am
possest to my Daughter Molly Garnett & her heirs forever Together with
all the Remainder of my Estate Except the Legacies hereafter to be mentioned
In case of the Death of my said Daughter before she comes of age or Marries
then it is my Will that my Lands pass to my Nephew James Garnett Tallant
Jrno & John Tallant Jrno & their heirs forever Together with all the Remain
der of my Estate Equally as a Mark of my Esteem & Friendship for my
Nephew James Garnett Tallant Jrno I give him one Mares Coll by

her side known by the name of Diamonds as a Mark of my esteem
 & friendship for my Nephew John Tatterson I give him One young
 Saddle Mare Colt two years old & as a Mark of my esteem & friend-
 ship for my Nephew James Gannett I give him one Black
 horse known by the name of Honey Tom & lastly I appoint my
 Good Brother Muscoe Gannett & my worthy Friends Hancock &
 Thomas Boulware Executors of this my last Will & Testament.
