forever. Item I give one half of the remainder of my Estate unto my son
Thomas Carnal and his heirs forever. The other half I lend unto
my daughter Betty Gouldman during her life and after her decease
to be equally divided among her children to them and their heirs
forever. My will and desire is that my land, Stock, Household

 Furniture and Estate of every nature or property save except
 negroes be sold to pay my last debts and the sixty six pounds given
 (my) son John Barnal's daughters above and lastly I appoint my son
