& memory do make & declare this my last will & testament
in manner & form following I leave unto my beloved wife
Margaret Lee during her life the land conveyed to me by John
Dee last deceased containing about three hundred acres being part
of the tract purchased by the said John Lee last mentioned of John
Kob
I then give & devise unto my son Hancock Lee & his heirs forever
the said three hundred acres of land after my wife's decease in lieu
of & as satisfaction for two hundred pounds sterling given him by
the said Hancock Lee of the province of Maryland but if any son
of the said son of two hundred pounds sterling then I give & devise
the interest in the said land hereby devised to him & his heirs forever

my executors hereafter named. If the money arising from such sale be
divided amongst such of my younger children as shall be living
at the time of my wife's death.

at the same of my wife
I now direct that all the real Estate of any estate of whatever
or kind I own or so much of it of my executors shall find conveyance
shall be sold for the discharge of my debts and the surplus I
devise to my said wife & her children & my younger children equally
to be divided between them my said wife to enjoy her proportion
of such surplus so long as she shall continue my widow & no longer
Lastly I constitute & appoint my friends Wilson Gurnett &
William H. Young executors of this my will & authority whereof
I have subscribed set my hand & seal the 24th day of April 1847
