voking all other Wills heretofore made by me), do dispose of my worldly ef-
fects in the following manner— I give and bequeath unto my
beloved wife Sally Grant Baker, all my Estate both real and personal to
her and her heirs forever, it is my desire that all my Just debts shall be
paid and that my Executors and Executors hereafter named shall dispose of
such part of my Estate either real or personal as they shall think proper
for that purpose— I do appoint my beloved wife Sally Grant Baker exor-
cise Executor, and my friend James Jones Executor to this my last Will and
Testaments. Witness my hand and seal the 17th day of June 1789

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at a Court held for Essex County at Saffordham on the 14th day of December 1789.

This Testament was last Will of John Baker deceased, being presented and sworn by James Jones Gentlemen one of the executors herein named, and proved by the oath of John Breckenridge, Rebecca Jones and Betty Ramsey who being witnesses to the said Will, and also by the oath of the said Executors the same is ordered to be recorded, and a certificate is granted to the said James Jones in order to his obtaining a probate of the said Testament in due form.
