 Thomas Edmondson at Wanchester had silver to get made. I Give & bequeath
 to Josiah Allen Son of Richard Allen twenty five pounds Cash to him & his
 heirs forever to be paid by Richard Allen when he shall come to the age of twenty
 one years out of the money he borrowes of me. I Give & bequeath to my

ever all the Remainder of my Estate Consisting of one young mare one
 wheat fan all the brood one mans Saddle Brady money debts some house
 hold and kitchen furniture to be equally divided. And Lastly I do here
 by nominate & Appoint my Brother Andrew Allen & Richard Allen Ex-
 -cutors of this my last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & Seal this fourteenth Day of March One thousand
 seven hundred and Seventy nine.
