

In the Name of God Amen, I Nathan Breedlove of Essex County being very sick and weak in Body but in sound mind and Memory do think fit and proper to make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth Viz

In the first place my desire is that my Just Debts & Funeral expences shall be paid by my Executors hereafter named Item, I give and bequeath to my Son Geo. Breedlove that part of my Land that my brother James Breedlove formerly lived upon, and that my Son John Breedlove now lives upon seperated from my other Land by a Dog Wood line tree Standing near Mr Manns from that Tree a straight course to a pi. Gummon Tree standing by the head of a bottom, thence down the Bottom to the head of a Branch, and down the Branch as far as my land extends to him and his heirs forever lawfully begotten of his Body

and in case he should die without Heir lawfully
begotten of his Body then the said land to descend to my
two other Sons Isaac and Nathan Breedlove.

Item I give and devise to my two other Sons and to the Child
that my Wife Mary Breedlove now bears all the residue of my
land to them and their Heirs forever lawfully begotten
of their Bodys and in case either of them should die
without Heir then the Deceased part to go to the Sur-
vivor. Item it my Will and desire that at my death all
my Personal Estate should be sold, and after my Wife
Mary Breedlove has her legal part thereof the profit

of the remaining part may be reserved by my Executors
 for my two Sons Isaac and Nathan Bredlove and
 the Child that my Wife is now Pregnant with until
 they shall arrive to such an age as they are thought fit
 to take care of it themselves.

Lastly I nominate and appoint John Mann and Peter Frible
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Wit-
 ness; Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
 this twenty Sixth Day of March One thousand
 Seven hundred and Eighty Six.
