their Increase forever I lend to my son Thomas Faulconer one
Negro named Humphrey which he has in his possession dur-
ing his and his wife's life and after their deaths then give
him to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten if no such heir
then the said Negro to return to my Estate and be equally di-
vided among all my children. I lend to my son Samuel Faul-
coner's children four Negroes, Rose Kate Phillimon and Sam.

- now with their future increase the said Samuel and his
wife to have the profits of their labours, during their lives &

Joel, William and Mary Natburt, I give to my grand daughter

one Negro named Fannie with her increase after my wife
deceases I give to Jane Garnett, one cow and half all the
rest of my Estate, I leave to my wife during her life &
after her death, I give to my son Samuel Fairbairn all my
land to him and his heirs forever, my will is so made
