in the following manner Viz^t I Give to my beloved Wife Mary Daniel my whole
Estate during her Natural Life and at her Death my Will and desire is that the Estate so
Givn her shall be equally divided between my Two Children Elizabeth and Polly Daniel to them
and their Heirs for ever and Lastly I appoint my Loving Wife Mary Daniel Executors
and John Montague Executor of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this Seventh Day of July 1785
