Item I do give & bequeth to my god son Edmon Brizondine one negro gal named
Fam she & her increase & one Feathered beed of Turnature to he & his heirs for
ever, Item I do give and bequeth to my god daughter Petra Bush one Feathered
beed of Turnature and Forty Shillings Spatha, to she & her heirs for Ever, Item
I do leave all the Rest of my Estate not yet mentioned to be Equally divided
between my brother william Cheameys Children that he had by his first wife

do ordain & constitute appoint my loving wife Dianah Cheameys of my brother
