

In the name of God Amen, I Richard Montague of the Parish of Southfarnham & the county of Essex being very sick and weak, but of sound mind & memory, thanks be given to Almighty God for the same, do make and ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following: First & principally I bequeath my Soul unto God who gave it, trusting on my Blessed Saviour for pardon & Remission of all my past sins & offences, and my body to be interred at the discretion of my Executors herein after named, & as to my worldly goods wherewith it has pleased God to bestow on me, I give & dispose thereof in manner following: Item I leave to my loving wife Charlotte Montague all my whole Estate both Real & personal during her natural life and after her decease my will & desire is that my whole estate that shall be left after the death of my wife both real & personal

shall be equally divided amongst all my surviving children and
their legal representatives; In case my child or children at the
base may be should die before they come to Lawful age or
heirs of their body; That then the whole of my estate except
what may come to me from my fathers estate; I give to my
loving wife & to her heirs forever. Item I give to my loving
wife my Matrimonial Certificate and Access Warrant. to her own
proper use; Lastly, I constitute, nominate & appoint my lov-
ing wife Executors & my Brothers, William Montague and
Philip Lee Executors to this my last Will and Testament,
In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and af-
fixed my seal this Third day of September, One thousand
seven Hundred & Eighty nine.
