sense and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
Revoking all other Wills in manner and form Following first all my just
debts to be paid then as to what worldly Estate I am blessed with I give
and Bequeath as is hereafter directed Item I lend unto my wife Susanna
Faver the one third part of my Estate both Real and Personal Dur-
ing her life. Also my will and desire is that the Remaining two
thirds shall not be sold except such things as is for the benefit of the
whole but shall Remain Together for the support of my Children after
married John, Clara, Mary, Thomas, Susanna, George, Elizabeth, and
Ann Faver But when any of my said Children shall Marry or come
of age then they may receive their proportionable part of the two thirds
except the land which is to be cultivated for the support and schooling
of the younger Children and if any one part or more shall be taken
from the whole then that do so Receive to have what such a part may
amount to left in the Division that shall be made

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Direct That is, when my wife shall depart this life, my will is that then
my Executors hereafter named shall sell the whole of my land for the
best price they then can get, and make a deed with warranty against
my heirs for ever, which Money with y^e whole of the other then
Remaining part of the totate including the part that was sent my

wife shall be equally Divided among my above named Children to them and their Heirs forever But if any one or more of them shall then be dead and leave no Children or Child, my will and Desire is the Division shall be among them then living. Lastly I appoint my wife Executrix and my Sons John, Thomas, & George Executors to this my last will and Testament in witness I have here put my hand and fixed my Seal the 1st day of March 1786
