Julias Dunn, fourth Choice of my negroes, & third choice of Beds and furniture
to him and his heirs for ever Item I Give & bequeath unto my son Thomas

Tobias Dunn. fourth Choice of my negroes, & third choice of Bedd and furniture
 to him and his heirs for ever Item I Give & bequeath unto my son Thomas
 Dunn, one Shilling Sterling to him & his heirs for ever Item I Give all the
 remaninder part of my Estate, that's not already disposed off, be it of what kind
 soever to be equally divided, between my Children by name as follows Edmund,
 Ann Presley & Tobias Dunn, to them & their heirs for ever. And Lastly, I
 appoint my friend William Edmondson Esq to execute this my last will &
 testam^t as witness my hand & Seal, & dated this the 7th day, of November
 One thousand seven hundred & eighty five
