is to live at any of my places that she shall think proper — Item I give & bequeath to my son
William son Galewood the tract of land lying on the bank which came by my father Mother &
my negro man Sam & my Gun. Violon & Horn & plate & my wearing apparel to him & his
heirs forever — Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Clara Galewood the tract of land where I now
live which I purchased of Thomas Peaves to her & her heirs forever — Item I give & bequeath to my
Daughters Hannah and Patty Galewood the tract of land I purchased of Robert Dunn to be equally
divided between them to them & there heirs forever — Item I give & bequeath to my brother James
Galewood my part of the land whereon he now lives. Item I give & bequeath to my three Daughters
Hannah, Clara & Patty all the Remainder of my estate consisting of negroes, black house
& old furniture &c. to be equally divided to them & there heirs forever. Lastly I nominate & Appoint my
Sister Amy Galewood & Richard Allen And my Brother Isaac Galewood Managers of my last will
and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this third Day of May One Thou-
sand Seven Hundred & Eighty Two.
