to them & their heirs forever. IWM if my Brother Birkhead Hawkins
dies without Lawfull heirs of his body that my Said shall go to my
Brother Thomas Hawkins to him & his heirs forever. IWM I give to
my Cousin Mary Sandrum one negro by name Fanny to her & her
heirs forever. IWM I give to my Sister Margaret Hawkins one negro
by name Judith to her & her heirs forever. IWM I give to Brother Thomas
Hawkins three negroes by name John Moses & Peter with their increase to
him & his heirs forever. IWM & the rest of my estate not mentioned, I give to
my Brother Birkhead Hawkins to him & his heirs forever. IWM if either
The rest of my legatees dies without Lawful heirs of their own body my
Will & Desire is that their part so dying shall be equally Divided among the
rest then living. Lastly I appoint my Brother Thomas Hawkins and
Birkhead Hawkins Executors of this my Last will & Testament. In witness
