hundred & sixty six Between Daniel M<sup>r</sup> Carty of the County of Fairfax & Colony of Virginia  
gentleman, Attorney of Bryan Fairfax late of the said County & Colony but now of Mortlake  
in the County of Surry in the Kingdom of England Gentleman, of the one part, and  
Margaret Green of the same County & Colony Widow of Charles Green Clerk deceased of the  
other part, whereas the said Bryan Fairfax by his special Letter of Attorney bearing  
Date the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of August in the Year 1765. duly proved before Sir William Stephenson Knight  
Lord Mayor of the City of London, and certified under the Seal of the Office of Mayoralty of the  
said City, did ordain constitute authorize & appoint the said Daniel M<sup>r</sup> Carty his true and  
lawful Attorney among other things giving & granting unto him the said Daniel M<sup>r</sup> Carty  
full Power & lawful authority for him the said Bryan Fairfax in his Name, & for his use to gra  
sign & execute a Deed to the said Margaret Green for & during the Term of her natural Life of a  
certain Tract of Land lying & being between Accotinck Run and the long Branch in the said County  
and Colony containing by Estimation one hundred & ninety seven Acres to be the same more or less, with all  
& every the Appurtenances therunto belonging at & under the yearly Rent of one peper Corn if  
demanded, as by the said Letter of Attorney reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear  
large appear Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Daniel M<sup>r</sup> Carty by Virtue  
of the above recited Letter of Attorney, & to comply therewith, as well as for & in consideration of  
the yearly Rent & Acknowledgement & Covenants herein after reserved & mentioned, and  
for divers other good Causes & Considerations him hereunto moving & Halt in the Name and  
Behalf of the said Bryan Fairfax demised granted set & to farm let, and by these presents doth  
in the Name & Behalf of the said Bryan Fairfax demise grant set & to farm let unto the said  
Margaret Green all that Heysage Tenement Plantation & Tract of Land situate lying & being in  
the said County of Fairfax & Colony of Virginia between Accotinck Run & the long Branch  
whereon the said Bryan Fairfax lately dwelt containing by Estimation one hundred & ninety  
seven Acres, to the same more or less, formerly purchased by the said Bryan Fairfax of the said  
Charles Green Clerk & Margaret his Wife by Deed dated in or about the Year 1761. commonly  
called or known by the Name of Greenhill together with all Houses Buildings Gardens Orchards  
Meadows pastures Fences Woods Underwoods Ways Waters water-courses Adverages Privileges  
Commodities & Diversments Appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise  
appertaining To have and to hold the said Heysage Tenement Plantation & Tract of Land  
with all & singular the Premises & Appurtenances unto the said Margaret Green from the Day of  
the Date hereof for during the term of her natural Life, yielding and paying yearly & every  
Year during the said Term to the said Bryan Fairfax his Heirs & Assigns or to his or their  
certain Attorney the Rent of one peper Corn on the Feast of St Michael the Archangel only  
if the same be lawfully demanded, And the said Margaret Green for herself her Heirs Execu  
tors & Administrators doth covenant promise & agree to & with the said Daniel M<sup>r</sup> Carty in  
the Name & Behalf & for the use of the said Bryan Fairfax at the Expiration of the said Term  
whenever the same shall happen, to deliver up the said hereby devised Land & Premises  
with

with all singular & appendances unto the said Bryan Fairfax his Heirs & Assigns  
or to his or their assigns, Attorney, And the said Daniel McCarthy in her Name and  
Behalf of the said Bryan Fairfax doth covenant promise grant & agree to & with the said  
Margaret Green that she the said Margaret Green shall & may under the said Deed or  
Acknowledgement & Covenant herein before mentioned peaceably & quietly have hold use occupy  
possess & enjoy the said hereby devised Land & Premises with the furniture of their Appurtenan-  
ces for & during the Term of the natural life of her the said Margaret Green aforesaid  
without any trouble, Distress, molestation or interruption from him the said Bryan  
Fairfax his Heirs & Assigns or other person or persons  
claiming as to claim by force or under him them or any of them. In witness whereof  
the said Party to these presents have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals
