

This Indenture made this 22nd day of July in the year of our Lord God one thousand Seven hundred & Sixty Six Between Robert Mops of the County of Loudoun & Colony of Virginia of the one part and Hannah Crump late Widow of Udam Crump Gent^l deceased of the County of Fairfax and Colony aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas there is a Marriage (by Gods Grace) shortly to be had and Solemnized Between the said Robert Mops & Hannah Crump an Infant Daughter of Hannah Crump the late Widow of Udam Crump Gent^l deceased and whereas the aforesaid Hannah Crump the mother of the aforesaid Hannah Crump her Daughter, being willing that the Marriage now Intended should on any Terms take Effect and be carried into Execution Between the said Robert Mops & Hannah Crump her Daughter, and if in Case her aforesaid Daughter after the Marriage had taken Effect should depart this Life without any Lawfull Heirs of her Body Begotten by the aforesaid Robert Mops that then and in that Case all the Estate Right and Title which her aforesaid Daughter Hannah claims in Consequence of her Father Udam Crumps last Will and Testament, which said last Will and Testament is Recorded amongst the Records for the County of Lancaster which may more fully appear Relation being thereunto had would be vested in the aforesaid Robert Mops partly to those presents, so that it would ^{not} be in the power of the aforesaid Robert Mops either by Sale in his Life Time or by his last Will and Testament to divert the aforesaid Estate which the said Hannah claims as aforesaid to any Person or Persons that he the said Robert should think proper, or if in Case he the said Robert should die Intestate that then, and in such Case the aforesaid Estate of the aforesaid Hannah Crump the Daughter would descend and become the Estate of the Heirs of the said Robert on the side of his Father by means whereof John Bushrode Crump and James Crump two of the Brothers of the said Hannah Crump would be all together precluded, and shut out from any Title or Claim to their Sister Hannahs Estate in form aforesaid — Now this Indenture most Expresly Witnesseth and it is most firmly and absolutely agreed Between the parties to this present Instrument of writing that during the life of the said Robert & Hannah Crump the Daughter that it shall not be in the power of the said Robert Mops to make sale of any of the Negros belonging to the said Hannah which she claims as aforesaid, nor shall the same be made liable to any of his Debts which he has contracted before the Marriage, or may hereafter Contract either directly or Indirectly but that the said Robert Mops shall be possessed of the use of the Estate aforesaid for and during his own life & the Life of the said Hannah, if in case the said Robert Mops & Hannah Crump the Daughter of Udam Crump deceased should die without any Heirs Lawfully begotten of her Body the aforesaid Robert Mops and living then all the Right Title & Estate which she the said Hannah claims in Consequence of her Fathers last will and Testament above mentioned shall Instantly & without delay go pass and vest in John Bushrode Crump & James Crump the Brothers of the said Hannah to have and to hold to them the said John & James their Heirs, Exrs, Adm^{rs} & Assigns equally to be devised Between them, In Witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their Hands & Affixed their Seals the Day and Year first above written
