are hold & firmly bound unto our Sovereign Lord George
the third by the grace of God of great Britain France and
Ireland King Defender of the Faith & in the sum of Thirty
four thousand & ninety two pounds Tobacco which payment well
and truly to be made to our said Lord the King his heirs
and Successors we bind our selves and every of us our
and every of our heirs Executors & Administrators
jointly & severally by these presents Witness our hand
and Seals this Twentieth day of May Anno Domini 1767.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas
the above bound Sampson Dorrell is constituted & appointed
Sheriff of the County of Fairfax during pleasure by Com-
mission from the Governor under the Seal of the Colony
dated the twenty third day of October in the Year of our Lord One
thousand Seven hundred & sixty six - if therefore the said
Sampson Dorrell shall well & truly collect eight pounds of
Tobacco from every ~~fit~~habable person in the said County, being
the public levy for this present Year and pay the same to the
several persons to whom the same is payable according to
Law Then the above obligation to be void otherwise to
remain in full force & virtue
