of the County of Fairfax Gen^l as it is called and
firmly bound unto our Sovereign Lord George the third by the grace of God of Great
Britain France and Ireland King defender of the Faith &c. in the sum of One
thousand pounds To which payment well and truly to be made to our said
Sovereign Lord the King his Heirs & Successors we bind our selves Every of
us our Every of our Heirs Executors & Administrators jointly & severally
by these presents Witness our hands & seals this 21st day of January 1767

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above
bound Sampson Dorrell is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County
of Fairfax during pleasure by Commission from the Governor under the Seal
of the Colony dated the 14th day of October in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred & sixty six if therefore the said Sampson
shall well and truly collect all the Taxes accruing or becoming due to his Majesty
in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer
on or before the tenth day of June next ensuing according to the directions of
an act of Assembly made in the thirtieth Year of the Reign of his late Majesty
King George the second Then the above Obligation to be void otherwise
to remain in full force & Virtue
