

FRANCIS FAUQUIER, Esq;
His Majesty's Lieutenant-Governour, and Commander in Chief of
the Colony and Dominion of VIRGINIA:

To *Sampson Dorrell Esq.*

BY Virtue of the Power and Authority to me given, Commander in Chief of this Colony, I do hereby constitute and appoint you the said *Sampson Dorrell* to be Sheriff of the County of *Stafford* during Pleasure; and that you be accordingly sworn, as soon as conveniently may be: And before you are so sworn, or admitted into the said Office, you are to enter into Bond, before his Majesty's Justices of the said County, with two or more good and sufficient Sureties, in the Sum of One Thousand Pounds Current Money, to render to the Auditor and Receiver-General of his Majesty's Revenue a particular, perfect, and true Account, of his Majesty's Rents and Dues arising within the said County; and also due Payment to make of all other Dues and Fees put into your Hands to collect, within the said County, unto the several Persons to whom the same shall be due and payable; and true Performance to make of all Matters and Things relating to your Office, during your Continuance therein. And I do hereby command his Majesty's Subjects, inhabiting the said County, and others actually there, to be aiding and assisting you, the said *Sampson Dorrell* as Sheriff of the County aforesaid, in all Things belonging to your Office Sheriff.
