

# This Indenture,

Made the 7<sup>th</sup> Day of August

in the Year of our Lord,

One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty six

Bween Thomas Abury

of the one Part, and William Brammell

other Part, WITNESSET, That the said Thomas Abury for and in Consideration of the Sum of Five Shillings Current Money of Virginia, to him in Hand paid, by the said William Brammell at or before the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents, the Receipt whereof

William Brammell is hereby acknowledged, HATH Granted, Bargained and Sold, and by these Presents DOTH Grant, Bargain and Sell, unto the said William Brammell all that Tract or parcel of Land entitale lying and being in Fairfax County containing Seventy five acres Betwixne more or less bounded as followeth Beginning at a Spanish Oak on the South Side of Pennys Run in the line of the Land that John Brammell Bought of John Harle running thence westward North forty degrees west and westerly bearing poles to a small Red Oak on the side of a hill thence South South West Twenty one poles West fifty Poles to another Red Oak to the South West of the said land deceased by the South twenty degrees East Seventy two poles North Twenty seven degrees West fifty Poles to another Red Oak to a white Oak in said John Brammells thence along the said line North eighteen degrees East One hundred eighty three poles to a white Oak in the corner of John Brammells Tenement & thence course continued thence poles further to a white oak sayling to a Red oak in the side of a hill in Turberville where they Intersect run along the side of a hill Turberville South twenty degrees East to a Red oak corner to the Darnells in Barboursville thence along the said Darnells line South twenty degrees East two hundred and one pole thence back to the Beginning.

and all the Houses, Buildings, Out-houses, Ways, Waters, Roads, Commodities, Hereditaments and Appurtenances, whatsoever, to the said Premises hereby Granted, or any Part thereof belonging, or any wife appertaining: And the Reversion and Reversions, Remainder and Remainders, Rents, Issues and Profits, thereof: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or parcel of Land aforesaid

and all and singular other the Premises hereby Granted, with the Appurtenances, unto the said William Brammell his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, from the Day before the Date hereof, for and during the full Term and Time of one whole Year, from thence next ensuing, fully to be complete and ended: YIELDING AND PAYING, therefore, the Rent of One Pepper-Corn, on Lady-Day next, if the same shall be lawfully demanded; to the Intent and Purpose, that by Virtue of these Presents, and of the Statute for transferring Uses into Possession, the said William Brammell his executors administrators may be in actual Possession of the Premises, and be thereby enabled to accept and take a Grant and Release of the Reversion and Inheritance thereof, to him and his Heirs. IN WITNESS whereof, the said Thomas Abury hath hereunto set his Hand and Seal the Day and Year first above-written.
