my Heirs Executors Administrators. and assigns, unto
the s^d. Samuel Johnston his Heirs Executors admini-
strators &c. against me the s^d. Turner Crump my Heirs
Adm. &c. and against all other person whatsoever,
shall & will warrant & forever defend by Virtue of this
presents, In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this Eleventh day of March
in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred
& Sixty Seven
