former wills and Testements by me at anytime heretofore made first and principally

decent manner at the Directions of my Ex^r hereafter mentioned and as for what worldly Estate
I hath pleased God to bless me with I do give Devise and Dispose thereof in the Following
Manner first I will and Devise that all my just Debts be paid

I give and bequeath unto my Eldest son Nicholas Reagan a feather Bed and Furniture
Likewise I give and bequeath four hundred Acres of land unto the said Nicholas Reagan out of
this tract where I now live on to him and his lawfully begotten of his Body and in default
of such law to be equally divided amongst the Rest of my Children that is to say Sarah
Reagan which is the wife of Mr Tolbert so Ann Reagan constant Reagan And Mildred
Reagan and their lawfully begotten of their Body

I give and Bequeath to Ann Reagan a feather Bed and Furniture likewise I give and
Bequeath to Constant Reagan a feather bed and Furniture and likewise I give and bequeath
unto Mildred Reagan a feather bed and Furniture. I give and bequeath unto Constant
Reagan and Mildred Reagan the Remainder of this tract of Land to be Equally Devised
Between them both also the tract of Land at the new church wherein Tho Gafford lives
to be Delivered to them at the age of eighteen or at the Day of Marriage to them and their
