 of Human life do make and ordain this my last will &
 Testament

Imprinted my will and desire is that my Executors &
 hereafter mentioned do discharge all my Just debts by
 the sale of my real or personal Estate as my Ex^r shall
 think fit

Item I give and bequeath to John Evans an orphan
 Ten pounds to be paid when he comes of the age of Twenty
 one years,

Item I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Ramsay Daugh-
 ter of W^m Ramsay Thirty pounds

Item I give and bequeath to Charles Roch an orphan &
 boy now living in the same ten pounds to be laid out for his use

In such manner as the executors shall think fit
 Item my will and desire is that the above mentioned
 Charles Roch be put to school for three years his board &
 necessary expence to be paid out of my Estate

Item I give and bequeath to Ann Songden (now living
 with me) Twenty five pounds to be paid her when she
 comes of the age of Eighteen years and one half of my wear-
 ing apparel

Item my will and desire is that the above mentioned
 Ann Songden have three years schooling the expence
 with her board to be paid out of my estate

Item I give and bequeath to Sarah Masterson five
 pounds with one half of my Apparel the other being
 disposed of as above

Item I give and bequeath to my ^{loving} Brother Jonathan
 Gooding living in Cakham in the County of Rutland
 in England the remainder of my Real and personal
 Estate except what is already devised ^{to} him & his heirs for
 ever failing such heirs to my Sister Sarah Gooding and
 her heirs failing her heirs to my Brother Robert Gooding
 and his heirs

Item It is my desire immediately after my decease that
 my executors do write to my Friends at Cakham and
 make them acquainted with this my will & in Case no
 such persons or their heirs can be found or none of them
 appearing to make a claim in two years after publishing of
 this

This my will I then give and bequeath the said remainder
of my real and personal Estate to Elizabeth Dalton daughter
of John Dalton her and her heirs forever

Lastly I appoint my friends John Carlyle & John
Dalton Executors of this my will & Testament Witness my
hand I seal this ninth day of August 1761,
