fect mind & memory thanks be to God do make constitute & appoint this my
last Will & Testament in manner & form following.
Imprimis. I give & bequeath unto my well beloved friend Robert Jones of the
same County Town & Colony aforesaid all that sum of money together with
the Interest thereon which I now have or is my right in the hands of Mr. Robert
Coleman upon Little Tower Hill near St. Catharines in the City of London in the
Kingdom of great Britain which said sum of money was given or devised to me
by Cap^t Stephen Black Wood of the a^d Kingdom of great Britain & also all my
other Estate both real & personal of any kind & Condition whatsoever & where-
soever I give & bequeath unto the a^d Robert Jones to him his Heirs & assigns
forever. — And lastly I do make, nominate constitute & appoint the above named
Robert Jones the only Executor of this my last Will & Testament. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this sixth day

of February annoq^d Domini 1760.
